

RECTOR'S DECREE NO. 7/2026
ESTABLISHING FEES RELATED TO STUDIES FOR THE
2026/2027 ACADEMIC YEAR

Article 1

Base amount used to calculate study-related fees

- (1) Study-related fees under Section 58 of Act No. 111/1998 Coll., on Higher Education Institutions and on Amendments to Other Acts, as amended (the "Act"), and under the AVU Financial Management Rules (Annex 2 to the AVU Statutes registered with the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports on 7 October 2025) are calculated from the so-called base amount, which is announced each year by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports of the Czech Republic (the "Ministry").
- (2) The **base** for determining the fees associated with study was set by the MŠMT for the **academic year beginning in 2026** by letter No. MSMT-1410/2026-1 dated January 22, 2026, in **the amount of CZK 5,278** (in words: five thousand two hundred seventy-eight Czech korunas).

Article 2

Fees for activities related to the admission procedure

- (1) The fee for activities related to the admission procedure
 - a) pursuant to Section 58(1) of the Act, for all types of study programs conducted in the Czech language, is CZK 1,050 (one thousand fifty Czech korunas) for each application submitted.

b) pursuant to Section 58(4) of the Act, **for the Art in Context study program conducted in English, the fee is EUR 40 (forty euros) for each application submitted.**

- (2) The admissions fee is due no later than the application deadline.
- (3) Admissions fees are paid by bank transfer to the Academy of Fine Arts in Prague (AVU) account no. **3584260247/0100**, IBAN: CZ7101000000003584260247, SWIFT code: KOMBCZ PP (Komerční banka Praha 7),
variable symbol for fees for study programs in the Czech language - **100**
variable symbol for fees for the Art in Context study program - **115**
specific symbol for all of the above fees - **payer's birth number**
- (4) The fee for activities related to the admission procedure is income for the main activity of the budget.
- (5) Upon request, the applicant shall provide the Study Department with proof of payment for verification.
- (6) The fee for services related to the assessment of the fulfillment of the condition of previous education for admission to study pursuant to Section 48(4)(e) and (5)(c) of the Act is CZK 1,050 (one thousand fifty Czech korunas) and is payable by the last day of the deadline for submitting the application for study.
- (7) The fee for assessing whether you meet the previous education requirements for admission to study is income for the AVU's main activities.
- (8) The fee for activities related to the assessment of the fulfillment of the condition of prior education for admission to study is payable by bank transfer to the **AVU bank account no. 3584260247/0100**, IBAN: CZ7101000000003584260247, SWIFT code: KOMBCZ PP (Komerční banka Praha 7),
variable symbol - **112**
specific symbol for all the above fees - **the payer's birth number**

Article 3

Fees for extended study

- (1) Under Section 58(3) of the Act, **the fee for extended study** in individual bachelor's and master's programs is CZK 15,000 (fifteen thousand Czech korunas) for each commenced additional six-month period of study.
- (2) The fee for extended study is payable at least 90 days after the rector's decision on the assessment of the fee.

The fee for extended study shall be paid by bank transfer to the **AVU bank account no. 3584260247/0100**, IBAN: CZ7101000000003584260247, SWIFT code: KOMBCZ PP (Komerční banka Praha 7),
variable symbol - **113**
specific symbol for all the above fees - **the payer's birth number**

- (3) The fee for extended study is income for the scholarship fund.
- (4) The fee may be paid in two instalments. The first instalment must be at least one half of the assessed amount; the second instalment is due six months after the due date of the first instalment. The student must notify the rector in writing in advance of their intention to pay in instalments; otherwise, payment in instalments is not permitted.

Article 4

Fees for studying in a foreign language

- (1) The fee for studying the Art in Context study program conducted in a foreign language pursuant to Section 58(4) of the Act is set as follows:
 - a. for students who began their studies in the 2022/2023 academic year, in the amount of **EUR 5,000** (five thousand euros) per academic year.
 - b. for students who began their studies in the 2023/2024 academic year and later, in the amount of **EUR 6,000** (six thousand euros) per academic year.
 - c. for students in their final (third) year of study, in the amount of **EUR 3,000** (three thousand euros) per academic year.
- (2) The fee for a study program conducted in a foreign language is payable according to the decision of the rector, usually in two installments by the 15th day of the calendar month in which the semester began. Details are specified in the decision on the determination of the fee.
- (3) The fee for studying in a foreign language shall be paid by bank transfer to the **AVU bank account no. 3584260247/0100**, IBAN: CZ7101000000003584260247, SWIFT code: **KOMBCZ PP** (Komerční banka Praha 7),
variable symbol - **114**
specific symbol for all the above fees - **the payer's birth number**.
- (4) The fee for studying a study program conducted in a foreign language pursuant to Section 58(4) of the Act is income from the main activity of the budget.
- (5) After paying the fee for studying a study program conducted in a foreign language, the student is required to submit proof of payment to the study department for verification upon request.
- (6) Students have the right to appeal against the decision on the assessment of the fee to the rector of AVU. When deciding on an appeal against a decision to assess a fee, the rector may reduce the assessed fee, waive it, or defer its due date if the

decision is contrary to the law, AVU internal regulations, or taking into account, in particular, the student's academic results and social situation.
